JOB GOAL:

To provide each enrolled student of secondary school age an opportunity to participate in extracurricular athletic activities that will foster sportsmanship, physical skills, a sense of worth and competence, a knowledge and understanding of the pleasures of sport, and the principles of fair play

PERFORMANCE RESPONSIBILITIES:

- 1. Organizes and administers the overall program of co-curricular athletics, both intramural and interscholastic, for the district consistent with applicable administrative directives, School Committee policies, MIAA and NCAA regulations, and State and Federal laws and regulations
- 2. Maintains an active presence in the district's schools during the school day as well as during practice/game hours in the afternoon and/or evening
- 3. Provides leadership in the selection, recommendation, assignments, and supervision of athletic coaches and staff members
- 4. Evaluates all head coaches annually; consults with head coaches in the evaluation of assistant coaches
- 5. Assists the Principal in the evaluation of the Athletic Department secretary

- 6. Aides/coordinates with coaches in support of college recruiting visits/communication consistent with applicable NCAA and MIAA regulations
- 7. Fosters positive school-community relations by keeping the community aware of athletic programs; and works productively with Booster organizations, other community groups, and media outlets
- 8. Maintains relevant and up to date Athletic Department web and social media presence; oversees all sports teams' social media presence
- 9. Assures all athletic programs adhere to district branding protocols
- 10. Works with district administrators in support of facilities, advertising, and sponsorship activities
- 11. Assumes responsibility for the organization and scheduling of all interscholastic athletic events
- 12. Hires officials and police officers as required, and assumes general responsibility for the proper operation and supervision of home games
- 13. Arranges transportation for athletic contest participants
- 14. Develops and places into operation appropriate rules and regulations governing the conduct of athletic activities
- 15. Verifies and monitors each athlete's eligibility according to established physical and academic requirements of eligibility for participation in each sport
- 16. Prepares and administers the athletic program budget including the requisitions of supplies and equipment
- 17. Oversees the distribution and collection of equipment and uniforms
- 18. Supervises all ticket sales and fundraising events of the athletic program, and assumes responsibility for proper handling of funds, consistent with School Committee policies and district protocols
- 19. Arranges all details of visiting teams' needs, including lodging, meals, towels, gymnasium services and field assistance, as appropriate
- 20. Arranges field and gym practice schedules and assures that practices are properly supervised
- 21. Undertake teaching responsibilities as may be required

- 22. Arranges for the physical examination of all athletes
- 23. Administers the insurance program covering school athletes and assumes responsibility for all processing of reports and claims
- 24. Keeps records of the results of all middle and high school athletic contests; and maintains a record file of all award winners, stating the date and type of award, including athletic scholarships
- 25. Directs an in-school, intramural program designed to foster support for the athletic teams and school spirit among non-participants
- 26. Plans and supervises recognition programs for school athletes
- 27. Reports for duty whenever necessary during the evening, weekends, and summer months, as needed, to oversee sports physicals and the arranging of coaches meetings and other related activities
- 28. Any other duties as assigned
